Jacob Nasser, 68, of 63 Garfield Street in Yonkers, was arraigned earlier today before Queens Criminal Court Judge Ira Margolis on charges of seventh-degree criminal possession of a controlled substance, endangering the welfare of a child and public lewdness. If convicted, he faces up to one year in jail. He was ordered held on \$3,500 bail and his next court date is May 9, 2007.

Nasser, a school bus driver, who is charged with public lewdness after taking a group of Bronx middle school children to a Mets game on the afternoon of Wednesday, May 2, 2007 and observed in the Shea Stadium parking lot sitting on the school bus with his pants down around his ankles and masturbating with the assistance of a mechanical device.

Legal Aid attorney Meggan Ways represented the defendant for arraignment purposes only.

It should be noted that a criminal complaint is merely an accusation and that a defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
