QUEENS MAN ARRAIGNED ON MURDER AND ASSAULT CHARGES
IN WEEKEND MOTOR MAYHEM

*Four Individuals Injured And One Dead After Motorist Allegedly Drove Into Crowd
Following Stabbing of Two Individuals;
Defendant Faces Up To 25 Years To Life In Prison If Convicted*

Adrian Harry, 22, of Beach 67th Street in Arverne, Queens, was arraigned last night before Queens Criminal Court Judge Toko Serita on a criminal complaint charging him with one count of second-degree murder, one count of first-degree assault, two counts of first-degree attempted assault, five counts of second-degree assault, six counts of first-degree reckless endangerment and two counts of fourth-degree criminal possession of a weapon. If convicted, Harry faces up to 25 years to life in prison.

Harry is charged with allegedly stabbing two people and then driving his vehicle through a crowd of people – striking five individuals, including one of the stabbing victims, and killing one – outside of an Ozone Park lounge just before dawn on Sunday. The incident allegedly was ignited by a petty parking dispute.

District Attorney Brown said, “What allegedly began as a minor tapping of fenders turned into a deadly pre-dawn horror show that left a young man dead and others seriously injured. The crimes alleged here are beyond senseless and the defendant now faces a lengthy term of incarceration if convicted.”

Harry was ordered held without bail and to return to court on January 4, 2018.

Harry was represented for arraignment purposes only by Susan Silverman, Esq. (718) 225-4740.

It should be noted that a complaint is merely an accusation and that a defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.

DEPONENT STATES, BASED UPON INFORMATION PROVIDED BY WITNESSES KNOWN TO THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO THE QUEENS COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AS WELL AS FROM VIDEO SURVEILLANCE THAT WAS RECOVERED FROM SEVERAL LOCATIONS IN PROXIMITY TO THE ABOVE MENTIONED PLACE OF OCCURRENCE, AND FROM THE DEFENDANT'S ADMISSIONS THAT ON THE ABOVE MENTIONED DATE, TIME, AND PLACE OF OCCURRENCE THE DEFENDANT, ADRIAN HARRY, STABBED WITNESS # 1, A PERSON KNOWN TO THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE QUEENS COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, ONE TIME IN THE TORSO, AND STABBED WITNESS # 2, A PERSON KNOWN TO THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE QUEENS COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, ONE TIME IN THE ABDOMEN.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES, BASED UPON INFORMATION PROVIDED BY WITNESSES KNOWN TO THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO THE QUEENS COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AS WELL AS FROM VIDEO SURVEILLANCE THAT WAS RECOVERED FROM SEVERAL LOCATIONS IN PROXIMITY TO THE ABOVE MENTIONED PLACE OF OCCURRENCE, AND FROM THE DEFENDANT'S ADMISSIONS THAT ON THE ABOVE MENTIONED DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF OCCURRENCE THE DEFENDANT, ADRIAN HARRY, DROVE A WHITE 2016 HYUNDAI SONATA ONTO THE SIDEWALK, ADJACENT TO LIBERTY AVENUE, AND DROVE THROUGH A CROWD OF PEOPLE STRIKING WITNESS # 2, WITNESS # 3, WITNESS # 4, WITNESS # 5, AND WITNESS # 6, ALL BEING PERSONS KNOWN TO THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE QUEENS COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AND ALSO STRIKING VICTIM, RICHARDO CHATTERGOON AKA "MOSES."

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE RESPONDED TO THE ABOVE MENTIONED LOCATION AND OBSERVED THE BODY OF RICHARDO CHATTERGOON LYING ON THE SIDEWALK; MR. CHATTERGOON WAS PRONOUNCED DEAD ON DECEMBER 3, 2017, AT 5:00 AM BY AN EMPLOYEE OF FDNY/EMS AMBULANCE BUS # 50D.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE IS INFORMED BY THE MEDICAL LEGAL INVESTIGATOR DISIGLIA, OF THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF MEDICAL EXAMINER OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, WHO RESPONDED TO THE SCENE, THAT THE INJURIES TO THE DECEASED VICTIM RICHARDO CHATTERGOON APPEAR CONSISTENT WITH BEING STRUCK AND DRAGGED BY A MOTOR VEHICLE.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE IS INFORMED BY DR. JUVIN, OF THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT OF A LOCAL AREA HOSPITAL, THAT WITNESS # 2 SUFFERED BLEEDING TO THE BRAIN AND IS CURRENTLY IN A MEDICALLY INDUCED COMA.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE IS INFORMED BY DR. JUVIN, OF THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT OF A LOCAL AREA HOSPITAL, THAT WITNESS # 3 SUFFERED A FRACTURED PELVIS, FRONTAL LOBE HEAD BLEEDING AND WILL REQUIRE SURGERY.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE IS INFORMED BY DR. LAM, OF THE EMERGENCY ROOM

OF A LOCAL AREA HOSPITAL THAT WITNESS # 4 SUFFERED A BROKEN NOSE AND CONTUSIONS.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE IS INFORMED BY DR. PERSAUD OF A LOCAL AREA HOSPITAL, THAT WITNESS # 5 SUFFERED SWELLING TO THE HEAD AS WELL AS BRUISING AND SWELLING TO THE LEG.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE IS INFORMED BY WITNESS # 6 THAT SAID WITNESS SUFFERED BRUISING AND SWELLING TO THE LEGS AND ARMS AND WAS TREATED AT A LOCAL AREA HOSPITAL.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT THE ABOVE MENTIONED 2016 WHITE HYUNDAI SONATA WAS RECOVERED.

DEPONENT FURTHER STATES THAT SHE IS INFORMED BY DETECTIVE SCARRY (TAX #925267) THAT HE RECOVERED A KNIFE FROM THE ROADWAY OF LIBERTY AVENUE IN THE VICINITY OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED PLACE OF OCCURRENCE; SAID KNIFE HAD WHAT APPEARED TO BE BLOOD ON IT.
