## <u>ARRAIGNMENT UPDATE:</u> <u>RICHMOND HILL MAN INDICTED FOR MURDER</u> <u>IN DEATH OF 92-YEAR-OLD WOMAN</u>

Victim Sexually Assaulted in Street and Found Naked From the Waist Down; Woman's Death Was First Homicide of 2020 in Queens County; Defendant Faces 25 Years to Life in Prison if Convicted

Defendant Reeaz Khan, 21, of 134<sup>th</sup> Street in the Richmond Hill neighborhood of Queens was arraigned today on an indictment before Queens Supreme Court Justice Kenneth C. Holder charging him with 3-counts of murder in the second degree, 1-count of manslaughter in the first degree, 1-count of attempted rape in the first degree, 1-count of sexual abuse in the first degree and 1-count of tampering with physical evidence.

Justice Holder held the defendant without bail and ordered him to return to court on February 24, 2020. If convicted, Khan faces 25 years to life in prison.

It should be noted that an indictment is merely an accusation and that a defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.
